*It's time to start planning for the
60th Annual Healdsburg Future Farmers Country Fair
May 26 thru 28, 2010.*

Enclosed are entry forms for the livestock exhibits. There should be a sufficient amount for your entire animal project membership. **All animal exhibitors must fill out the top portion of the market entry form.** In addition, all breeding animal exhibitors must complete a breeding animal entry form listing each animal to be exhibited. There are separate forms for large animal (*swine, sheep, beef, goat and dairy*) and small animal entries (*poultry, rabbits, cavies and dogs*). This year you will also find the DNA packets for swine included in your packets. The swine will need to be eartagged and DNA packets completed and turned in with the entry forms. If you have any questions regarding this procedure please contact Marci Jacobs or Sheri Smith. Club leaders should submit all entries and monies attached to the individual entry forms to the fair board in one group packet. A

Copies of the **2011** fair rules are included with your entry forms. We remind all exhibitors that all market animals sold at auction will be processed. Animals judged "Not Market Ready" will not sell at auction.

Market & breeding classes are scheduled for Friday **May 27th** for beef, hogs, sheep, goat, poultry and rabbits. **Please note that there will be premium money awarded in the large animal classes: 1st place: \$30; 2nd place: \$20, 3rd place: \$10.**

The \$20 entry fee per MARKET animal earns that exhibitor two books (20 tickets) of Sir Rusty tickets. The exhibitor can recover the cost of the entry fee(s) by selling the tickets, or he/she may choose to keep the tickets. These "entry fee tickets" are not counted as part of the usual quantity of tickets portioned out to each club for general sales.

REMEMBER: All exhibitors must show in a Showmanship class for each market species entered in order to be able to sell that species at the Auction.

A member of the fair board will be happy to meet with your club prior to the Fair in order to review all aspects of the **2011** Fair procedures and to answer questions anyone may have. Please contact us for more details.

P.S.: We encourage the livestock exhibitors to do their best to find as many auction buyers as possible. They might suggest that buyers unite to buy an animal if they otherwise cannot afford to, or do not have freezer space for a whole animal. Also, remind potential buyers of the "Resale" option.
